**Subject: Corrective Action Taken as a Result of Routine
Inspection No. 90-001**

Gentlemen

As a result of the inspection conducted August 28, 29, 1990 and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure C (Enforcement Policy) (1990)", the following corrective steps have been taken to correct violations identified during the inspection:


- A. An Amendment Application to Materials License 20-22729-05 and SUB 1410 was submitted on November 20, 1990. A request to change calibration of instruments from semi-annual to annual was itemed.
- B1. Surveys are scheduled to be conducted at least every six months including December 1990.
- B2. Our last incoming shipment of isotopes was in August 1986. Our plating operations for the past five years (minimum) have only involved DU aircraft counterweights under a contract with Nuclear Metals. Incoming packages of radioactive materials shall be monitored for condition of packaging and evidence of contamination.
- B3. We have likewise, in our recent Amendment Application dated November 20, 1990, requested that film badges be changed from a 2 week interval to a monthly interval.
- C. Surveys shall be conducted and records of the survey results shall be maintained in accordance with license requirements effective immediately.

- D. We have under our Amendment Application of November 20, 1990 submitted a change in our Radiation Protection Officer and also changes in membership of our Isotope Committee.

Upon approval of the amendment application to change the Radiation Safety Officer responsibilities from A. Mitton to M. Cronan, the Textron Defense Systems radiation program will be fully under the jurisdiction of the Industrial Safety and Environmental Protection Department. As manager of this department, I will initiate the means to verify that license requirements are met.
