Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of Revision 3 dated August 23, 1990, and Revision 4 dated January 20, 1991, of the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit 2, Radiological Emergency Response Preparedness Plan.

We have reviewed these changes to the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit 2, Radiological Emergency Response Preparedness Plan and have determined that these changes are consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(q) and do not decrease the effectiveness of the emergency plan. Therefore, these changes are acceptable.

We note that with Revision 3 you have changed your emergency response philosophy to that of a team approach from one more focused on individuals. Considering this change, we would caution you to ensure that emergency responders continue to receive appropriate annual retraining and that previous response time commitments can still be met.

We also noted, and confirmed through discussion with Mr. K. Morris of your staff, that Figure F-2, "Direct Ring Telephone Circuits Between Emergency Response Facilities", is in error. Omitted from the figure is the connection from your Technical Support Center (TSC) to the Monroe County Sheriff. This should be corrected with your next regular revision to the Plan.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
