This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated October 31, 1990, in response to the Notice of Violation issued to you as a result of Inspection Nos. 030-01326/88-001 and 030-12537/88-001.

You state, in your reply to the Notice of Violation, that the teletherapy unit has been decommissioned. You do not say whether the teletherapy unit has been dismantled and the cobalt-60 source remains in storage at your facility or if it has been transferred for disposal. If it has been transferred for disposal to an authorized disposal company, you may submit appropriate documentation to the Commission certifying disposal and make application to terminate your teletherapy license.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.
