This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. Henson and Mr. M. Fuller of this office on March 30, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Hato Rey, Puerto Rico facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license with respect to radiation safety and compliance with NRC regulations and the conditions of your license. It included selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel and direct observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC Requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.
