Thank you for your response of September 18, 1992, to our Notice of Violation, issued on July 31, 1992, concerning activities conducted under NRC License No. 52-01946-07.

In your responses to Violation A.1 and A.2.a., you questioned how the inspector identified the improperly stored radioactive waste as Iodine-125. In discussions with the authorized user, the inspector determined that Iodine-125 was the only radioactive material he was using at the time.

We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.
