FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Sir:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. §552) and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's ("NRC") policies and regulations (10 C.F.R. §9.3 et seq.), I hereby request that copies of the following records be furnished to me:

- (1) Any document that pertains to failures of, problems with or defects in generators manufactured by E.P. Portec, Inc., Electric Products Division; Parsons Peebles Electric Products; Parsons Peebles Electric Products, Inc.; or NEI Peebles Electric Products, Inc., which are a part of an emergency diesel generator at a nuclear power plant
- (2) Any document that pertains to failures of, problems with or defects in any electric generator pole of any emergency diesel generator at a nuclear power plant.

As used herein, "NRC" refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and any official, employee, special government employee, consultant, or advisory committee thereof as well as any other person, entity or governmental body providing


information or comments germane to this request for publicly available records.
