To the Freedom of Information Act officer:

I am a reporter for The Tampa Tribune newspaper. Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, I am requesting copies of all documents, including all memos, pertaining to the investigation of an allegation referred to in Allegation Report RII-90-A-0135 - Crystal River, including the allegation report itself and the utility's response.

I understand the documents may contain unsubstantiated allegations involving activities at Florida Power Corp.'s Crystal River nuclear plant. I believe it is the public's right to know about possible safety-related allegations when they come before the NRC.

If you believe it is necessary to black out the names of persons named in the allegations, please cite the legal authority for doing so and please refer to the individuals as "person 1" and "person 2" or in some manner so the documents will be intelligible.

An Aug. 27, 1990, letter to the utility from Luis A. Reyes, director of the Division of Reactor Projects, says information about the allegations was not placed in the Public Document Room in order to "avoid an unwarranted invasion of privacy or defamation of character of named individuals." Since the NRC's reason for keeping the file private is clearly to avoid invasion of privacy or defamation, I feel safe in assuming you will provide me with documents that make clear the nature of the allegations.

I request that fees for copying the records be waived since I am requesting this information for possible inclusion in a news story, which is intended to ultimately benefit the public at large. If you believe a fee is required, please notify me before making the copies if the fee will exceed \$50.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) you believe justifies your refusal to provide the information and include the appeal procedures available under law.

I thank you in advance for your attention to this request and look forward to hearing from you within 10 days, as the law stipulates.

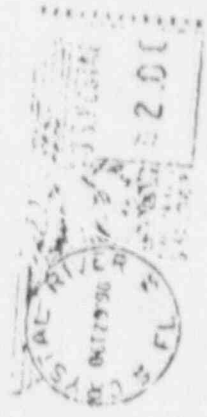

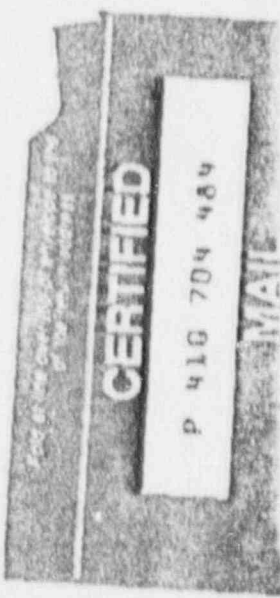
