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SUBJECT: FIRE PROTECTION RULE-ALTERNATE SAFE SHUTDOWN CAPABILITY-SECTIONS III.G.3 AND III.L OF APPENDIX R TO 10 CFR 50-NORTH ANNA POWER STATION, UNITS NO. 1 AND NO. 2 (NA-1&2)

We have completed our review of the subject as noted above based on your submittal (Serial No. 370) dated June 22, 1982 and as amended by your submittal (Serial No. 547) dated September 30, 1982. Our enclosed Safety Evaluation (SE), incorporates the technical input provided by our consultant, the Brookhaven National Eaboratory. The alternate safe shutdown capability of NA-1&2 in the event of a fire was evaluated against the requirements of Sections III.G and III.L of Appendix R to 10 CFR Part 50.

Based on our review, we conclude that NA-1&2 is in compliance with Title 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix R. Items III.G.3 and III.L regarding safe shutdown in the event of a fire. The schedule for you to complete required modifi-cations is specified in 10 CFR Part 50.48(c)(4). Also, it is noted that should any of the completion dates for required modifications be extended beyond the time limit as specified in 10 CFR Part 50.48(c)(4), VEPCO must submit an application (with adequate basis) for an exemption to the Fire Protection Rule. Finally, it is noted that it is our understanding that VEPCO has not requested any exemptions for NA-1&2 at this time. Compliance with the Fire Protection Rule will be the subject of future Commission inspections.
