Dear Mr. McDonald:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), the Aerospace Industries Association requests that it be provided certain documents pertaining to a change in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) made by Item XIII - Revaluation of Assets, of Federal Acquisition Circular Number 84-58 dated July 23, 1990. This change amends FAR 31.205-10, -11, and -16, and adds 31.205-52 to assure that the Government does not recognize depreciation, amortization, or the cost of money expense flowing from asset write-ups that result from the "purchase method" of accounting for business combinations. Available information indicates that DAR Case 88-146 is pertinent.

The following documents are requested:

1. A copy of the Defense Acquisition Regulatory Council's (DARC) decision covering its deliberations and approval of the revision.
2. A copy of all DARC subcommittee reports pertaining to the revision.
3. A copy of all Department of Defense senior management memoranda/letters pertaining to the revision.
4. A copy of all memoranda from the Civilian Acquisition Agency Council pertaining to the revision.
