REEVALUATION AND AFFIRMATION OF NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGE FINDING PURSUANT TO THE RIVER BEND STATION, UNIT 1 POST OPERATING LICENSE ANTITRUST REVIEW

On November 19, 1993, counsel representing Cajun Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., the City of Lafayette, Louisiana, Louisiana Energy and Power Authority, and Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, requested a reevaluation of your "Finding of No Significant Changes" pursuant to the post operating license antitrust review of the captioned plant.

Enclosed for your signature are an affirmation of your finding and a Federal Register notice. Staff's conclusion is that requesters' concerns have been adequately addressed in your original finding which stated that the issues raised by requesters should be reviewed in the context of a compliance proceeding.

Normally, your finding will become a final staff action 30 days after publication in the Federal Register unless the Commission exercises sua sponte review. However, in an effort to accommodate the licensee's request to complete this action this calendar year, we anticipate recommending that the Commission exercise its authority to permit the Director's reevaluation finding to be considered final when the Projects staff is authorized to issue the license amendment to River Bend.
