
5. Description

5,600 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 243,000 kilograms uranium enriched to 4.0 w/o maximum, as UO₂ powder, fuel rods or bundles.

The amendment, when issued pursuant to this request, will:

- a. reference conditions 6 and 8 set forth on form NRC 250A;
- b. retain the present expiration date: 31 December 1989;
- c. amend the original license issued November 17, 1978 and subsequent amendments through number 3 issued October 13, 1982; and
- d. document consent of the Australian Government to the export as required by 10 CFR 110.50(b)(4) effective October 6, 1982.
