EXPIRATION OF CLEVITE CORPORATION LICENSE SWN-153 ON AUGUST 31, 1962

The subject licensee has advised us that they do not wish to renew their special nuclear material license which expires August 31, 1962. My letter dated May 28, 1962, we informed Clevite of the contamination levels we believed should be met and requested a report on the levels existing after decontamination. By letter dated August 14, 1962, Compliance copy attached, they have provided information regarding the amounts of fixed and removable contamination remaining after their completion of decontamination.

As you know, under the Act and 10 CFR 70 a person who possesses special nuclear material, unless specifically exempted, must be licensed, and there are no minimum quantity limits below which a license is not required. Accordingly, unless a determination is made that the amount of special nuclear material present as contamination is de minimis Clevite would be required to retain a license in order to continue to possess the contaminated equipment and facilities.

For this reason we are requesting that an inspection of the Clevite facilities be performed, if possible, prior to August 31, to determine the validity of the values reported in the August 14, 1962, letter. Please notify us as soon as possible after the inspection of the findings.
