SUBJECT: CLEVITE CORPORATION - DOCKET 70-133

Leo Dubinski called me this afternoon and indicated that one of his inspectors had visited the Clevite Corporation on August 30, 1962, to determine the validity of contamination levels reported to us by Clevite after they had completed decontamination of their facility. We had requested this inspection in our memo of August 24, 1962. Mr. Dubinski indicated that Clevite had apparently done a good job in reducing the contamination levels to the lowest practicable point and that although the independent smears taken by the inspector had not yet been analysed, it appeared that the levels furnished by Clevite were valid. He indicated that Clevite had used both soap and water and a steam hose as part of their decontamination efforts. He also indicated that it did not appear that there were any areas where contamination might exist and not have been detected by Clevite's survey program. He mentioned that Clevite had taken about 126 smears of the facility to determine the levels of contamination. He indicated a report of the investigation and the results of the inspector's survey would probably be available next week.
