## I. SECY-82-439 - Nomenclature Changes to Implement Executive Order 12356

The Commission by a vote of 5-0,\* approved for publication a Federal Register Notice making minor amendments to 10 CFR Parts 2 and 9 for consistency with requirements of the new Executive Order 12356, "National Security Information," and the Information Security Oversight Office Implementing Directive. Accordingly, you should forward the amendments to SECY for publication in the Federal Register.

## II. SECY-82-428 - San Onofre Licensing Board Certification Regarding Proceeding on Medical Arrangements Issue

The Commission by a vote of 3-2\*\* (Chairman Palladino and Commissioners Ahearne and Roberts approving, Commissioners Gilinsky and Asselstine disapproving), approved an order that responds to the San Onofre Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order certifying a question to the Commission. The Order suspends the proceeding until further notice.

Commissioner Roberts was not present when this item was affirmed, but previously indicated that he would approve. Had Commissioner Roberts been present, he would have affirmed his prior vote. Accordingly, the formal vote of the Commission was 4-0 in favor of the decision.

\*\* Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." Commissioner Roberts was not present when this item was affirmed, but had previously indicated that he would approve. Has Commissioner Roberts been present, he would have affirmed his prior vote. To enable the Commission to proceed with this case without delay, Commissioner Asselstine, who was a member of the minority on the question up for decision, did not participate in the formal vote. Accordingly, the formal vote of the Commission was 2-1 in favor of the decision.
