Dear Sir:

Due to some higher than anticipated ground water samples, we sunk three sampling wells into and around the leach field for further analysis. These have been labeled SF-1, SF-2, and SF-3, and are shown on the revised Exhibit 1 (Ref. 1) which is enclosed. The wells were pumped and the initial samples have been analyzed by CEP and these results are also enclosed. These samples reveal that the level of contamination previously indicated does not appear to be present. Additional testing will be performed in order to confirm actual activity levels in the water. Finally, Isotopic Uranium values for the Pipe-1 sample which were not included in ref. 6 noted above have now been added to the data along with a revised first page to show the latest revision date.

EXHIBIT 1 - LEACH FIELD


