SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY

This meeting summary is a record of specific meetings held between the NRC staff and applicant personnel during the period from October 19, 1982 through October 29, 1982. A copy of the meeting notice is enclosed (Enclosure 1). Additional meeting summaries will be issued periodically as required to record any future meetings related to Enclosure 1.

On October 22-21, 1982 applicant representatives (F. Baxter, D. Aggarwal and K. Kiper) met with the NRC staff (J. Knox and L. Mheeler) to discuss an applicant draft of a response to a request for information developed at a previous meeting on associated circuits (specifically, RAI 430.149 was developed at a meeting in Bethesda on September 10, 1982; the draft response was provided to the NRC on September 20, 1982). The discussions included a consideration of the staff evaluation of the applicant's position as described in a working draft of the relavent portion of the Seabrook Safety Evlauation Report (Enclosure 2). As a result of this meeting the applicant forwarded a final response to 430.149 on October 26, 1982. The working draft of the SER will be updated to include an evaluation of the final response. There were also discussions to clarify the status of other open items related to the Power Systems Branch review.

On October 26, 1982 applicant representatives (A. Legendre, S. Floyd, R. Belanger, and K. Kiper) met with L. Wheeler and the reviewers from most of the technical review branches to review the status of open items related to the safety review (and one item associated with the environmental review). Dates were established as deadlines for the applicant to provide each branch with the remainder of the responses that are due.

K. Kiper has been presentein Bethesda on a daily basis to meet with L. Wheeler to coordinate the timely submittal of information to the staff, and to keep the staff appraised of the status of applicant responses.
