SUBJECT: WITHDRAWAL OF A PORTION OF AN AMENDMENT REQUEST FOR THE SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT, UNITS 1 AND 2 (TAC NOS. 76048 AND 76049)

By letter dated February 1, 1990, Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) requested amendments for Operating Licenses NPF-76 and NPF-80 for the South Texas Project, Units 1 and 2. The amendments requested 22 changes to the technical specifications (TSs) based on a probability risk analysis. By letter dated November 27, 1990, HL&P withdrew four of the requested changes. The four withdrawn changes concern the auxiliary feedwater system (TS Section 3/4.7.1.2), essential cooling water (TS Section 3.7.4), diesel generators (TS Section 3/4.8.1.1), and DC electrical sources (TS Section 3.8.2).

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Amendments to Facility Operating Licenses with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
