SUBJECT: CONCERNS REGARDING NINE MILE 2 MSIVs

The concerns you expressed to me in your February 17 note regarding the Nine Mile 2 MSIVs have been transmitted to DRS management via the attached memorandum. As indicated in the memorandum, based on our February 17 telephone conversation, it is my understanding that you agree the current Nine Mile 2 license conditions are adequate and that it is not necessary to rescind or add additional conditions to the Nine Mile 2 license at this time. If my understanding is incorrect, please inform me immediately, in writing, of what additional action you believe are necessary with regard to the Nine Mile 2 license.

Your concern regarding the problems that have been experienced with the Nine Mile 2 MSIVs is shared by Regional management and these problems will have to be satisfactorily resolved before the existing construction deficiency reports are closed and reactor operation can begin. As always, I and DRS management are available to discuss technical issues or concerns you might have.
