SUBJECT: Reply To a Notice of Violation of Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License SNM 1998

Dear Gentlemen:

The U.S. Army Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment Activity was cited for a violation of NRC License Number SNM 1998. The violation was written for failure to comply to a condition in the license to require local radiation protection officers to submit a quarterly radiation summary to your headquarters.

This violation occurred because the license is a new license and is not fully implemented. At this time, only 3 of our 92 field sites use material covered by this license. This violation was an administrative oversight.

To correct this deficiency, a form has been mailed to these three locations to obtain the missing information. In addition, to prevent future violations, a quarterly radiation report form was added to the computerized leak test letter format. This letter is automatically sent out each quarter and, as updated, will provide a vehicle to ensure the quarterly report is submitted according to the NRC license conditions.

This activity will be in full compliance no later than February 28, 1994.
