SUBJECT: ALLEGATION REGARDING USE OF INSPECTION TRAINEES AT NINE MILE POINT UNIT 2

This is to document a telephone call referred to me by the Public Affairs Officer at 2:15 p.m. on September 17, 1982. The call was discussed with you on the same day.

The caller identified himself as [redacted]. He stated that he had [redacted] been terminated from Stone and Webster Engineering Corporation at Niagara Mohawk's Nine Mile Point Unit 2 site. He further stated that he had been a Level I electrical inspector. He sounded very angry and felt that he had been terminated because of [redacted] and that he was ready for certification as a Level II inspector but they (S&W) would not certify him. He further stated that he planned to pursue his termination with the Department of Labor. [redacted] did not request confidentiality nor (per policy) did I offer it.

He stated that electrical inspector trainee's were being used to sign off inspections of electrical raceway installations because they did not have enough Level I or Level II inspectors. I asked him for names and he slurred some first names which I could not identify. I informed him that we would look into his allegation. He stated that he planned on moving back to Boston, but would not provide an address or phone number. The call was then terminated.

I requested the resident inspector to determine the validity of the allegation. We will keep you informed of our findings.
