## Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 26, 1994, and your check for \$17,500 in payment for the civil penalty proposed by NRC in a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty (Notice) dated December 28, 1993.

Your corrective actions for several of the violations in the Notice were discussed during a telephone conversation between Mr. John A. Grobe and Ms. Elizabeth Peterson on February 10, 1994. During that conversation, you provided the following additional information:

Your corrective actions for Violation A.6 included: (1) the authorization of Building 404, Location W42, Yermo Annex, as a radioactive materials storage area; and (2) the examination of all other storage areas by the Base Radiation Safety Officer to assure proper radioactive materials storage.

You will submit a license amendment before March 15, 1994, modifying the alarm set point for the Johnson Air Monitor as part of your corrective actions for Violation A.8.

By January 1, 1994, you updated the implementation of your radiation safety programs to conform with the revisions to 10 CFR Part 20.
