SUBJECT: CHANGES TO THE COMANCHE PEAK PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN, REVISION 17

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated December 3, 1993, by which you transmitted changes to the Physical Security Plan for your facility.

We reviewed the changes in your letter and the attachments. Except for two changes in paragraph 11.2 involving the devitalization of diesel generators, the changes were consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p).

The two changes we found to decrease the plan's effectiveness and also could result in a violation of Technical Specification involved with the devitalization of unit diesel generators. Revision 17 did not include conditions that stipulated when diesel generators could be devitalized. The previous plan conditions required that: (1) the applicable unit be in Technical Specifications Operational Mode 5 (cold shutdown) or Operational Mode 6 (refueling) for both diesels to be devitalized, and (2) the other condition stipulated that one diesel generator can be devitalized during any operational mode for the purposes of repair, replacement, or major maintenance.

This issue was discussed with your Security Manager on February 2, 1994. He stated that the two previous conditions were inadvertently omitted in Revision 17 and that a plan revision will be submitted to reinstate the original conditions. That change should be submitted within 90 days. Based on your commitment to reinstate the previous conditions, the proposed changes are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.
