Per my phone conversation with Richard Milstein concerning the submittal of the aforementioned license application, Cabot Performance Materials has been requested to send a letter addressing the fact that the application has been delayed.

While the submission of the application was originally scheduled for the end of December 1993, it became apparent that the timeframe would not be met. At that time, we wrote a letter stating that we would attempt to submit the application near the end of January 1994.

We have made an extra effort to submit the application near the end of January, but simply will not be successful in our attempt. Due to the extremely severe weather conditions we experienced in January, we were forced to operate with less than full staffing.
