COMMENTS *During a telephone conversation between Bruce Quade and Nina Pugh of our offices on November 30, 1990, Ms. Pugh informed Mr. Quade that a copy of the contract requested in item one of your letter and identified on enclosed Appendix A is available at the NRC's Public Document Room (PDR). Ms. Pugh provided the PDR's telephone number to Mr. Quade as he indicated he would call the PDR to obtain a copy of this contract. In regard to item three of your request, Ms. Pugh informed Mr. Quade that attached to the requested three latest status reports identified on enclosed Appendix B were copies of computer programs which were originated by System Automation Company and are considered proprietary information to this company. Ms. Pugh asked Mr. Quade if he would agree to the deletion of these computer programs from the status reports as proprietary information is not routinely released to the public. Mr. Quade agreed to having these programs deleted from the status reports. Also, contained throughout the status reports are names of company personnel. Ms. Pugh asked Mr. Quade's agreement to the deletion of these names as they are routinely considered to be proprietary and also are not released to the public. Mr. Quade agreed to having the names deleted from the status reports. In regard to item two of your request, Mr. Quade was informed that the invoice reports are under review and will be responded to in a subsequent letter. Copies of the records identified on Appendix B are enclosed.
