Gentlemen:

This letter constitutes a supplement to our response to the subject Report, QA-1884, dated July 21, 1982, concerning reporting of 10CFR50.55(e) events to the Commission.

With regards to the "Corrective Action Taken to Avoid Further Noncompliance" section of the response, in addition to the commitments already made, CG&E will provide additional training for CG&E site personnel to the reporting requirements of 10CFR50.55(e).

Personnel to be trained include those in the Nuclear Engineering, Generation Construction, Nuclear Production and Quality Assurance Departments whose duties include the processing, review and approval of Nonconformance Reports (NRs), Corrective Action Requests (CARs), Audit Findings (AFRs), Condition Evaluation Requests (CERs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs). Training will include indoctrination to identification of significant deficiencies in design and construction and the established procedure for bringing such deficiencies to the attention of appropriate levels of management. In addition, document reviewers will be instructed to the applicability of reporting requirements during their reviews of past NRs and CARs to identify potentially reportable items to responsible management. All training will be completed by September 30, 1982.

We trust the above will be found acceptable as a supplementary response to the subject Report.
