Gentlemen:

This refers to the meeting conducted by Mr. James G. Keppler, Regional Administrator and members of his staff on November 3, 1982 at the office of the United States Attorney in Chicago with Mr. Gregory Jones, First Assistant United States Attorney and other representatives of law enforcement agencies.

The meeting was scheduled at the request of Region III to provide the appropriate law enforcement authorities the final results of the investigation conducted by the NRC at the Zion facility during the period December 23, 1981 through June 15, 1982. The investigation was conducted as a result of several allegations concerning the use of drugs and drug related operational problems, the conduct of the licensee's management during their investigation into drug use and other allegations relating to the conduct of plant employees and security guards. This meeting fulfilled a commitment made by Region III management during a meeting with these same law enforcement agencies on January 6, 1982. During that meeting, the NRC and the law enforcement agencies agreed that the NRC should take the lead in this investigation and inform these agencies of the results.

The detailed description of the investigation is documented in a report (Reports No. 50-295/81-32(DETP); 50-304/81-30(DETP)) which was presented to the licensee earlier on the day of this meeting. The report was hand delivered to appropriate law enforcement representatives on November 4, 1982.

The Regional Administrator opened the meeting by discussing its purpose and conduct. He explained that a meeting on this subject had just been completed with Commonwealth Edison management in which we had briefed them on the results, findings, and requested actions related to this investigation.

In order that all those present understood the perspective of the report, findings, and requested actions, the Regional Administrator provided a brief summarization of the investigation.

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The briefing was then continued by the Director, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Operational Support. His presentation included a discussion (by means of projected slides) of the conduct of the investigation, the allegations which are delineated in the report, and a short synopsis of relevant background information regarding each allegation. The "conclusion" for each allegation was read from the body of the investigation report. The law enforcement representatives' questions were answered as they were asked.

The briefing concluded with a presentation of the "Findings" and "Requested Actions" described in Appendix B to our November 2, 1982 transmittal letter. Each of the ten findings and requested actions was summarized by projected slides. The contents of Appendix B was read for the benefit of those present. The law enforcement representatives were informed that the licensee would address each of the requested actions in writing to the NRC.
