On November 18, 1982, the West Valley Agricultural Protection Council ("West Valley"), submitted a "Supplemental Memorandum" supporting West Valley's earlier Petition to Intervene. 
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(see NRC Counsel's letter of November 24, 1982) in respectfully requesting that West Valley's Supplemental Memorandum be stricken from the record.
