- 89/05/C3: Based on a written request from the Regional Administrator dated May 2, 1989, OI:RI is being requested to determine the veracity of statements made by Licensee Management, particularly the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), at an Enforcement Conference held on April 26, 1989.
- 89/05/31: Interviews of 4 NRC officials were conducted to establish the nature and scope of the alleged false statements made by RTI officials at the enforcement conference (EC). Pertinent records at RTI were reviewed and a letter mailed to NRC by RTI's RSO which apparently mitigates one of the alleged false statements at the EC was made part of the investigative file. A contact with RTI plant superintendent regarding the review of RTI records was documented. Interviews of the irradiator operators are being scheduled. ECD: 89/06.
- 89/06/30: Interviews of the four operators at RTI were accomplished, as well as two material handlers, the plant superintendent, and a maintenance man. Court reported interviews of the RTI management staff to include the President, two Vice Presidents, the Plant Superintendent, and the RSO were also completed. Relevant documents were obtained at RTI. It appears that RTI management was aware that two of the operators had breeched the access door by climbing it when it was locked and that management failed to disclose this fact at the Enforcement Conference. Investigation is continuing and it appears that one reinterview may be necessary as well as one interview of a secretary who was out of town during the conduct of the last series of interviews. Reinterview of RTI Vice President of Operations was conducted in order to confront him with marked discrepancies regarding his sworn testimony during previous OI interview. The Vice President admitted providing inaccurate information at the EC and during his OI interview, however, he denied intentionally doing so. A secretary was interviewed in order to resolve the issue of authenticity of a questioned document (letter submitted to NRC). It appears that the letter she typed for the RSO is legitimate and was not back dated. Additional RTI records were reviewed. OI learned that the RSO and Vice President of Operations are both resigning effective July 28, 1989. Investigation is continuing and reinterview of the RSO upon his resignation is contemplated. OI report to be completed by 89/08. ECD: 89/10.

89/08/31: Of draft report was written with the exception of agent conclusion section. Conclusion section is being held in abeyance to await legal opinion from OGC regarding 10 CFR 20.203. Draft ROI is in typing. Phone contact was made with the resigning RSO who extended his RTI employment by two weeks but he indicated that there is nothing else to report; a reinterview is not now contemplated. ECD: 89/11.

89/09/30: Field work complete. OI draft report is being reviewed by OI:RI supervision in preparation for issuance of final ROI. ECD: 89/12.

89/10/18: ROI is at 01:RI for review.

89/10/31: ROI completed in final and submitted to OI:HQ for review.

After the following operators were interviewed by the NRC they offered the following.

Mike Rosa indicated that he was questioned for 2.5 hrs. He was asked if he had been coached on what to say, he indicated he was not. He was asked if he felt the RSO was doing a good job, he indicated yes. He was then asked if he knew if any one was altering documents, he indicated no. He was asked if he knew of anyone breaching the cell door. Mike informed them of the time where Dave Smith and Bob Kiem climbed over the door to retrieve the meter and key that they had both on different occasions looked in the cell after doing a survey. They asked what was done about this. Mike told them of my meeting where this was discussed and a memo I whote concerning this matter. He also told them that we have now blocked this area so you can not climb over. Mike indicated to me that he was being asked the same questions over and over in different ways as if to cause him to change his over.

Bob Kiem offered the same information as Rosa

Mike Ayres indicated that in a conversation with Enriest Wilson by telephone, Enriest indicated that the upper management was telling the opposite to what the operators were saying. After the interview Mike offered that they asked him to review their notes from the enforcement meeting and tell them if there were any statements that were not accurate. Mike informed them that the looks had been interchange (see memor 6/12/89). Mike was also asked why he was not promoted to John Singletons position. Mike indicated that he was told he was more qualified for maintenance. They said they did not think that was the reason. Mike indicated that they told him that during the enforcement conference meeting that Shapiro and Varaklis said that Mike was blowing things out of proportion. Mike was also asked in there were memos being altered or post dated, Mike said no. They said something to the effect that this could be a Welt situation.

Dave Smith indicated that he had been grilled. He did not offer any more to me.

Joe Giarrocla did rot have much to offer except that he was asked if he the company had improved since the time he had been employed by Radiation Technology back during the Welt days. Joe indicated that there were good improvements.
