Dear Ms. Virgilio:

This letter is in reference to the subject All Agreement State Correspondence which requested written confirmation by January 25, 1994 concerning review of available file information about radioactive material licensees who were likely to have conducted medical or scientific radiation effects research on humans prior to dissolution of the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) in 1975.

The State of Nevada became an Agreement State in 1972. The Atomic Energy Commission transferred 45 radioactive material license files to the State at that time.

Review of available file information and interviews with program staff employed by the Nevada Health Division during the 1970s indicated that no Nevada licensees were authorized nor was any suspected medical or scientific radiation effects research on humans in Nevada documented during Division inspections.


