## (Granting Licensees' Request for Postponement)

By letter dated December 1, 1982, Consolidated Edison Co. of New York and the Power Authority of the State of New York (Licensees) have requested that we postpone the hearing scheduled for the week beginning January 3, 1983, to the week beginning January 10.½ Licensees argue that Westchester County's supplemental testimony is not due until December 29, 1982, which, because of the intervening holiday, would leave them with one day or less to prepare for a week of testimony. They indicate that they "require at least a full week to prepare adequately for a hear ng." Licensees represent that counsel for

In their letter Licensee's refer to the schedule contained in our "Memorandum and Order (Granting Licensees and Staff an Extension of Time) (Nov. 15, 1982)". We assume they meant to refer to our Memorandum and Order (Formulating Final Contentions and Setting Schedule) issued November 15, 1982.

Westchester County and for the NRC Staff do not object to a one-week postponement. Further, they assure us that a postponement to January 10 will not affect any other portion of the schedule.

Because the parties presenting evidence concur in the request, the Board has decided to grant the postponement.

ORDERED

That the hearing on prefiled testimony of Westchester County originally scheduled for the week of January 3, 1983, is hereby postponed to the week of January 10, 1983.
