Dear Ms. Wright:

The attached is General Electric Company's original NRC License application for 60,000 Kgs of natural uranium dioxide as powder and/or pellets which would be exported to GE Canada (fuel fabricator) and/or Canadian Mining & Energy Corp. (CAMECO). GE Canada will be supplying natural pellets and/or powder to our Wilmington facility. It is anticipated that some material will need to be returned to the GE Canada facility and/or Canadian Mining & Energy Corp. (CAMECO) for additional work. As our current schedule calls for a long term relationship, we are requesting the license for ten years.

Enclosed also is General Electric Company's check # 2485628 in the amount of \$3,300.00 payable to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the processing and issuance of this export license as required by law. This export license is required as soon as possible to assure first shipment by March 1994.
