The status of PECO's responses to LQB's request for additional information dated September 1, 1982 was also discussed. The applicant expected to provide most of the responses prior to the December audit.







LIMERICK GENERATING STATION UNITS 1 AND 2 FINAL SAFETY ANALYSIS REPORT


