SUBJECT: FEMA REPORT FOR THE 1992 PRAIRIE ISLAND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EXERCISE

We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated December 29, 1993, transmitting the findings for the offsite emergency preparedness aspects of the 1992 Prairie Island exercise conducted on September 15, 1992.

FEMA identified no new deficiencies in the performance of offsite agencies during the exercise; however, twenty-seven Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCAs) were identified.

We understand that many of the ARCAs have been resolved between the offsite agencies and FEMA and fully recognize that any further corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we would expect the subject of offsite preparedness for the area around the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Station to be addressed by you as well as others.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed FEMA report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
