Subject: RESPONSE TO CONSTITUENT INQUIRIES CONCERNING INTERIM LICENSING AT SHOREHAM

In preparing a response to the attached constituent inquiries forwarded to the agency by Representative William Carney, I would appreciate staff imput in answering several of the questions raised Specifically, I would like to know whether the Office of Resource Management has any estimate of the impact of the interim licensing provisions of S. 2330 with regard to the agency's budgetary or manpower resources, particularily in safety-related areas. Further, I would like to know to what extent plant operation under a temporary operating license would inhibit physical inspection of the Shoreham facility, as is suggested by the inquiry of Mrs. Romaine. I would also like to know what is 3/ the staff's position on the need for an independant inspection of the Shoreham plant, which I believe has been requested by several of the intervenors to the operating license proceedings for that facility.
