The following is response to the violation cited in your letter to Steve Shipper dated January 15, 1991.

In order to prevent future dispensing of incorrect pharmaceutical form, use of the "see-through" vial shields will continue. All labels identifying the vail shield of particular products will be removed. Only a label identifying the isotope, lot #, etc. will remain. Thus a new label is applied every time a product is compounded. The cold vials will not be placed in the vial shield until they are ready to be compounded. Whenever another pharmacist or technecian is present, they will double check the vial being prepared as what the preparer believes it to be. Dispensers have been re-instructed to look at the vial inside the shield before dispensing.

The above corrective procedures have already been place since November 27, 1990.
