(Motion to Show Cause)



Should Intervenors seek permission for an additional filing, they should file a motion by February 9, 1991: (1) listing, with document and page references, specific facts or arguments that have appeared for the first time in "Licensee's Response to Intervenors Rebuttal", and (2) for each fact listed, stating what Intervenors desire to show and that they have a witness or a citation to a legal authority or recognized code to

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support that showing. If Intervenors wish, they may attach affidavits which will be received in the written record only if their motion is granted.

Additionally, I encourage the parties to negotiate stipulations or a settlement of the case, perhaps along lines suggested by Licensee in its most recent filing.
