This Board is being established pursuant to a notice published by the Commission on December 21, 1990 in the <u>Federal Register</u> (55 F.R. 52337) entitled, "Consideration of Issuance of Amendments to Facility Operating Licenses and Proposed No Significant Hazards Consideration Determination and Opportunity for Hearing." The proposed amendment would

revise the technical specifications relating to the minimum required shutdown cooling flowrate. The amendment would reduce the required flowrate from 4000 gpm to 3780 gpm to provide additional margin for preventing air entrainment while the reactor coolant system is partially drained.
