5 MR. STEPTOE: Chairman Bechhoefer, we would like -- we

10 Staff has no objection.

11 CHAIRMAN BECHHOEFER: Ms. Stamiris, would you like

13 MS. STAMIRIS: Thank you.

14 CHAIRMAN BECHHOEFER: Does anybody have any objection?

23 CHAIRMAN BECHHOEFFER: Recross.

24 MR. STAMIRIS: Before I begin with that, I would like to
25 ask whether or not some of the questions that I want to ask on
recross at this point, I think they are going to be related to some
ALDERSON REPORTING COMPANY, INC.

1 of the issues in Contention 4, that we talked about. I wondered
2 if it would be possible to an extent to cover these questions
3 before we begin seismic shake down. Perhaps that would be the
4 most expeditious way to proceed.

5 CHAIRMAN BECHHOEFER: I think we should do that
6 right after lunch. Staff has indicated that it will not
7 ask any new questions.

8 MR. STEPTOE: Chairman Bechhoefer, I think that
9 our previous discussion introduced a red herring. I
10 certainly have no objection to Ms. Stamiris asking
11 questions about bearing capacity or seismic shake down,
12 but I don't see anything in Contention 4 which has
13 anything to do with either bearing capacities or seismic
14 shake down. I will object to questions outside the scope
15 of Dr. Hendron's testimony.

16 MS. STAMIRIS: Well I think if I ask my
17 questions, then you will have a better chance of
18 determining whether or not they do indeed have anything
19 to do with the issues raised in Contention 4. They are
20 related to testimony that Dr. Hendron has given this
21 morning, and I think that it will be apparent that they
22 relate to some of the issues in Contention 4.

23 CHAIRMAN BECHHOEFER: Would you prefer to do it
24 now or after lunch? You could come back in an hour.

25 MS. STAMIRIS: I think that would be preferable.
