Subject: Modification No. 1 to Task Order No. 17, entitled "Power Plant Engineering Course" under Contract No. NRC-26-91-290

The purpose of this modification is to modify the reporting requirements/deliverables of this task order and to extend the period of performance from November 30, 1993 to January 31, 1994, at no additional cost or obligation to the Government. The extension is needed to allow for minor changes to the course materials as identified in the course presentation report. Accordingly, the task order is hereby modified to read as follows:

1. Section 5 entitled "REPORTING REQUIREMENTS/DELIVERABLES," paragraph b., "Deliverables," add item no. (6) to read as follows:

"(6) Make minor changes to the course materials as identified in the course presentation report."

2. Section 6 entitled "PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE," is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"This task order shall be effective from August 23, 1993 through January 31, 1994."

3. The first sentence of Paragraph 2 of the definitization letter is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Task Order No. 17 shall be in effect from August 23, 1993 through January 31, 1994, with a cost ceiling of \$60,765.00."

A summary of obligations for this task order, from award date through the date of this action is given below:

This modification does not obligate any FY94 funds.

All other terms and conditions of the subject task order remain unchanged, including the ceiling amount of \$60,765.00.


