

NOTICE OF DEVIATION

Wisconsin Electric Power Company  
Point Beach Nuclear Plant

Docket Nos. 50-266; 50-301  
License Nos. DPR-24; DPR-27

The following deviation was identified during the inspection conducted from December 3, 1990, through January 15, 1991:

Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), section 1.8 states that; In matters related to quality assurance, the Manager (Point Beach Nuclear Plant) remains cognizant through direct involvement and through input from various sources including the in plant Quality Assurance (QA) Coordinator and QA Representatives. The QA Coordinator and QA Representatives are appointed by the Manager and are considered concurrent assignments.

Contrary to the above, the licensee does not utilize the position of QA Representative as detailed in the FSAR and plant procedures, and therefore, none are appointed. Additionally, the current QA Coordinator does not meet the the experience level criteria specified in the procedure.

Please provide in writing within 30 days of the date of this Notice: (1) the reason for the deviation; (2) the corrective actions that have been taken and the results achieved; (3) the corrective actions that will be taken to avoid further deviations; and (4) the date when your corrective actions will be completed. Consideration may be given to extending the response time for good cause shown.
