In view of the fact that a hearing will be held on July 26, 1973, at Washington, D.C. in connection with Arkansas Power & Light Company's application for an operating license for Unit 1 of Arkansas Nuclear One near Russellville, I am interested in obtaining definite information regarding the safety of my home which is located in a row of nine homes on Bunker Hill at varying distances approximately 1/2 mile more or less from the Nuclear plant. These homes are located between Lake Dardanelle and the Plant and their only access road is the one going by the Plant.

My home is on property bordering land that was previously taken by Arkansas Power & Light Company for safety purposes. I would appreciate learning of the opinion of the Advisory Committee on the safety of my location.
