Enclosed is a copy of the final exercise report for the December 9, 1992, exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans for the State of Ohio and affected local jurisdictions site-specific to the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. The State of Ohio partially participated and Lake, Ashtabula, and Geauga Counties fully participated in the exercise. This report was prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region V staff and copies will be forwarded to the State of Ohio.

There were no Deficiencies identified during the December 9, 1992, exercise. There were, however, thirteen Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified during the exercise. Region V staff will coordinate with the State of Ohio to correct the ARCAs on or before the next scheduled biennial exercise.

Based on the results of the December 9, 1992, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Ohio and the affected local jurisdictions site-specific to the Perry Nuclear Power Plant can be implemented and are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site.
