Biennial Reports

Dear Sir:

On December 28, 1993, Three Mile Island Unit 2 (TMI-2) entered into Post-Defueling Monitored Storage (PDMS). At that time, the PDMS Safety Analysis Report (SAR) represented the existing plant condition. PDMS Technical Specification (Tech. Spec.) Section 6.8.1.4 requires the submittal of biennial reports (i.e., once every two years) covering the activities of the unit as described below:

1. All changes made to the PDMS SAR; and
2. All changes, tests or experiments meeting the requirements of 10 CFR 50.59.

Per the PDMS Tech. Specs., these reports shall be submitted prior to March 1 of every other year and include the changes made during the previous two calendar years. In recent discussions with Ms. M. Evans, Senior Resident Inspector, TMI, and Dr. M. Masnik, TMI Project Manager, NRR, a common understanding was reached that the timeclock for the submittal of biennial reports started on the date of entry into PDMS. Therefore, the next biennial report


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documenting the changes made to the PDMS SAR and the plant pursuant to 10 CFR 50.59 will be submitted prior to March 1, 1996 and will include the changes made during the calendar years of 1994 and 1995. Subsequent reports will be submitted every two years thereafter.
