During our recent special inspection at Dresden site, we determined that we had neglected to include your July 31, 1990 change to Bases Section 3.10.F of the Dresden 1 Technical Specifications (TS) when we issued Amendment No. 37 on September 3, 1993. The bases change clarifies that fuel pool clean-up effort will continue until the desired cleanliness level can be reached and a Demineralizer System can be put in service to maintain water quality. Accordingly, the corrected TS page B.3/4.10-2 is enclosed.
