Dear Mr. Congel:

Enclosed is a copy of the final exercise report for the June 3, 1992, exercise of the radiological emergency response plans site-specific to the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant. The State of Michigan partially participated and the Counties of Monroe and Wayne participated fully in the exercise. This report was prepared by the Region V staff of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and copies will be forwarded to the State of Michigan.

There were no Deficiencies identified during the June 3, 1992, exercise. There were, however, five Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified. Region V staff will coordinate with the State of Michigan to correct the ARCAs on or before the next scheduled biennial exercise.

Based on the results of the June 3, 1992, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Michigan and affected local jurisdictions site-specific to the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant can be implemented and are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site. Therefore, the Title 44 CFR, Part 350, approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to the Fermi II Nuclear Power Plant granted on March 9, 1987, will remain in effect.
