The passive radon monitor TLD chips which we received from EDA to be placed on September 1, 1982 did not have the proper Mylar covering. For this reason, they were not placed but were given to Tim Smith of the Lakewood office to be exchanged with ones that had the proper Mylar covering.

With the exceptions of locations AS-201 and O'-3, all of the PRM's have the chips still in them that were placed August 1, 1982.

The PRM's at locations AS-201 and OV-3 were removed as the batteries were bad. New batteries will be installed at these locations.
