Dear Sir,

I am writing in reference to your letter dated January 17, 1989, docket # 99990002 regarding the nuclear ionizer model #205, serial #A39296.

I used to own one device using this ionizer and was on a yearly lease program from 3M. The lease was renewed each year in February. I had just received my new ionizer when it was recalled. I am enclosing two UPS pickup records showing where both this pieces were returned to 3M.

I think this inquiry is resulting from the fact that 3M shipped me two return packages for the recalled unit. I was in contact with the necessary 3M office to report this error and they advised me to throw out the extra packaging which I did. I was in contact at least two other times with them when I received further correspondence from them regarding the loss and presumed that they had taken care of whatever error they had made in their paperwork.

In response to your other question referring to our plans in obtaining similar static eliminator devices in the future the answer is no, we have returned the unit requiring this device to
