- In your proposed organizational chart in Technical Specification (TS)
 b, the box labeled Reactor Supervisor has been removed from the organizational chart. Please provide an explanation of this change.
- 2. In your proposed wording for TS 4.3.1.e., it is not clear that a test pulse would still be required semi-annually (interval not to exceed seven and one-half months) if routine pulsing (pulsing within each six month interval) were occurring. Please reword your proposed TS to require test pulsing semi-annually, but allow the test pulse surveillance to be postponed if a non-pulse interval of greater than six months occurs.
