

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on January 14, 1991, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1991) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 14.A. states that the license is based upon the licensee's statements and representations in certain referenced documents.

The referenced application dated December 17, 1988, states in Item No. 10 that the procedure for personnel external exposure monitoring published in Appendix D, of Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 2 will be followed. The referenced guide requires that all individuals who are occupationally exposed to radiation on an occasional basis will be issued a whole body monitor.


Contrary to the above, since approximately 1988, whole body monitors were not issued to all individuals occupationally exposed to radiation on an occasional basis. Specifically, during this period, only extremity monitors were issued.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
