STAFF RESPONSE TO NEW YORK STATES'S MOTION
FOR MODIFICATION OF HEARING SCHEDULE

On December 3, 1982, the New York State Energy Office filed a motion for modification of the Board's schedule for hearing testimony concerning Commission Questions 3 and 4. The State requested that the hearings on these two questions begin on March 14, 1983 instead of March 1, 1983. The reason given by the State for this request is the necessity for State and County witnesses, to participate in activities relating to the emergency planning exercise schedule for March 8, 1983.


FEMA witnesses who will be required to testify in this proceeding are also very heavily involved in the scheduled exercise. The two-week delay requested by the State could be accommodated without a change in the date for concluding hearings. This could be accomplished by holding continuous hearings beginning March 14, 1983 rather than the current schedule which provides for a two-week recess between hearings on Commis-

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sion Questions 3-4 and Commission Question 5. For this reason the Staff supports the State's Motion for a modification of the Board's scheduled hearing dates concerning Questions 3 and 4.
